Show us how to Balance Celebration and Grief

Intro: The Christian life is full of seeming contradictions; multiple factors that are in tension with each other. 'Don't rely on what you see or hear. Rely on what God says'

- A. Palm Sunday Procession: Matt. 21:1-11
 - one of only ten events accounted in all 4 Gospels (Matt 21, Mark 11, Luke 19, John 12)
 - Foretold in 4th Century BCE Zech. 9:9
 - Jesus also foretold it Matt. 21:2-4 (village donkeyowner-response-reaction)
 - Jesus knows and willingly engages the future (Phil. 2:5-11)
 - Son of David Matt. 1:1, 20:30 (blind men), 21:9 (crowds), 21:15 (children in temple), 2 Sam. 7:12-13,16 (eternal kingdom)

These are true: no matter what follows Hab. 3:17-19

- B. Passion Week: Matt. 21:12-27:54
 - The public display and affirmation are preparation for the tests ahead
 - Jesus told them beforehand: Matt. 20:17-19, Luke 18:31-33, Mark 8:31
 - As we go through the fire, we can remember the One who goes before us in knowledge and power, and we remember the One who willingly suffered in order to have relationship with us. No price was too great.

Conclusion: We recognize what's happening in our world and we return to commemorate the Triumph that Jesus displayed. He is the eternal King
