It's Pouring Out!

Intro: Fire and Rain, two opposing Spirit metaphors to celebrate Pentecost: the promise, and the experience. Acts 2 relates a story that is very tell-able in our day, sounds like a political convention- big, grand, loud, enhanced ability, drawing attention- so is this why we shrink from it personally while 'advocating' it institutionally?

- A. Demonstration not expectation (Acts 2:1-21, Joel 2:28)
 - compare Hong Kong demonstrations, Weddings, Baptisms
- B. It wasn't the beginning (Numbers 11:24-30) and it wasn't the End (John 20:19-23)
 - experiences of the Spirit from Creation, to Moses, through Judges, to Saul, Hannah's song, Elizabeth's song
 - Jesus' words show that there is on-going Spirit driven ministry
- C. Spirit Presence Can't be pinned down
 - Variety and Diversity defy our attempts at containment (I Cor. 12:3-13, Psa.104, Rom. 12)
- D. Always marked by Abiding Love
 - not orphaned: Comforter, Advocate (John 14:16, 26, 2 Cor.1:21)
 - Pursue love and strive for the spiritual gifts (I Cor. 14:1, 12)
 - for building up of the church,
 - Abides: I John 3:24, 4:13, 5:6-8

Concl.: Pentecost is the outward sign of the on-going relationship of God's Spirit which has been poured out upon us. Let's allow it to seep in, and establish our roots, not just run off.
