Things that make us uncomfortable

Intro: The Sound of Music – beautiful movie, lovely nanny, comforting children through a storm by singing 'A few of my favourite things'. Everything bad just disappears.

A church in crisis has to ask itself fundamental questions. Why do we gather? Would the neighbourhood notice if we closed? What is our calling? Have we fulfilled it? It is a good idea to consider these before we get to the point of crisis. All the texts from the lectionary for today have uncomfortable messages. What shall we do, since we come to church to be encouraged? Just sing louder?

- A. Conflict makes us uncomfortable: Jer. 20:1-6, Matt 10: 34-38
- B. Stiff Neck makes us uncomfortable: Jer. 7:14-15, 20:10, 22:21-22
- C. Injustice(hopefully) makes us uncomfortable: Rom.6:1-2, Heb. 4:12, Matt. 21:13, Jer. 22:13-17

Conclusion: Reconciliation is the center of our work.
