Intro: This is Grad. season. Photo ops in every park each evening. Young people dressed as adults parading around. Posters hailing their accomplishments on front yards and businesses. Reminders are everywhere that these young adults have passed the test. But anyone familiar with Abraham knows that he wasn't a perfect student. Gen.22:1-14

- A. Not a Mensa candidate: Abraham had plenty of 'failures', but God
 - 'she's my sister' Gen. 12
 - 'not my wife' Gen. 20
 - he's my nephew Gen. 13, 14,19
 - I'm fatherless- Gen. 16
 - you can't stay here- Gen. 21
 - that's my well Gen. 21
 - we can't stay here 11:31, 12:4, 12:10, 13:1, 13:17, 20:1
- B. Know when it's exam time 22:1
 - not meant to eliminate but elucidate, to reveal: 22:12
 - answer the question: 22:8
- C. The Examiner 'Kakch-na' 22:2
 - he did not spare his only Son Romans 8:32

Conclusion: Love the Lord your God with all your heart. God wants you, personally, wholly.
