Reconciliation with Creation

Intro: what's the connection between creation and redemption We need to know what we are waiting for.

- A. Sufferings of this present time Rom. 8:18
 - circumstances, family, age, finances, employment, covid-19
 - creation waits, subject to futility
 - v.22 whole creation has been groaning
 - v.23 it and We 'We're in this together' even though we have the first fruits of the Spirit we still groan, <u>inwardly</u>, and we WAIT
- B. Future Glory Rom. 8:18b like comparing apples and oranges
 - v. 21 <u>in hope</u> the creation **itself** will be set free
 - no more decay: FREEDOM
 - v 24 in hope we were saved: SALVATION=REDEMPTION=ADOPTION
 - Jer. 3:23, I Thess. 5:8, 2 Peter 3:15 Examples of hope of salvation
 - we haven't seen it, but we hope for it, and we WAIT for it with PATIENCE

Conclusion: we need to appreciate how closely we are united to all of creation; and we need to remember that we join in waiting with creation for salvation. Maybe we can even learn the patience of waiting through observance of creation.
