**September 30 - National Day for Truth and Reconciliation**

In response to Call to Action #80 of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission, the courageous advocacy of Indigenous survivors (Orange Shirt Day) and the recent, stark findings of unmarked graves at residential schools, September 30th is now recognized as a federal statutory holiday. This is a day to provide Canadians with an opportunity “to honour Survivors, their families, and communities, and ensure that public commemoration of the history and legacy of residential schools remains a vital component of the reconciliation process” (TRC). We encourage all our churches to participate in local commemorative gatherings, to take time [to reflect on the TRC reports](#), to consider [Mennonite involvement](#) in the Indian school system and to prayerfully commit to [a step of learning and action](#) for right relations.
