Frozen meals for less fortunate families: Here are some details regarding last week's announcement about preparing these meals, and how we at Zion can participate in this response to the request from Swift-Link which was in our mailslots recently. Bart will head up the preparation and freezing of 30 meals, each meal to serve a family of 4. The meals will be simple, so not a lot of help is required with the preparation. A few individuals have already expressed interest. **However, help is needed in two areas: Making muffins** - 6-8 muffins are needed to accompany each meal for 4. These (any amount) could be made at home, then left in the Zion kitchen deep freezer with a note stating what kind they are. **Money** - to pay for the meals (estimated at \$250.). Donations (again, any amount) are receiptable because Zion executive has approved this project.
