Summer Meal Request

Similar to last year, a request has come from SwiftLink for family meals for the Early Learning Family Resource Centre (ELFRC) in Swift Current during the summer months. Churches are asked to provide 30 family meals which will be given to ELFRC participants each Friday during July and August to take home for their families. Zion has signed up for one Friday (one week). Bart will prepare the meals, and freeze them. Assistance is needed with the cost of ingredients estimated at \$350. Also needed are 15-18 dozen muffins to go with the meals. SwiftLink provides fresh vegetables and fruit to help balance the meals. If each Zion household would donate \$20 and 8-12 muffins to this cause, the need would be easily met. When the goal is reached, the congregation will be advised, so we don’t overdo it! Please designate your \$ donation on your offering envelope, and leave your muffins in the kitchen freezer.
